At that, the evil spirit screamed, threw the man into a convulsion, and then came out of him.

Response to God's Word:

- You have called us to be a light to the world, so that those in darkness come to you. [take a moment to pray for those you know and don't know who aren't yet followers of Jesus]
- O God, may our lives shine as a witness to the saving grace you have given for all.
- You have called us as members of your body, so that when one suffers, all suffer together. [take a moment to pray for those are sick, alone, poor, homeless, or hungry]
- O God, we ask for your help, comfort, and healing power to bring hope to those who are sick and in need this day.
- Jesus, Lord of the Church, hear our prayer, and make us one in heart and mind to serve you with joy for ever.

Leader: Gathering our prayers and praises into one,

Communion:

Leader: The Lord is here.

People: His Spirit is with us. Leader: Lift up your hearts.

People: We lift them to the Lord.

Leader: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God. **People:** It is right to give thanks and praise.

Leader: It is right to praise you, Father, Lord of all

creation; in your love you made us for yourself. When we turned away you did not reject us, but

came to meet us in your Son.

All: You embraced us as your children and welcomed us to sit and eat with you.

Leader: In Christ you shared our life

that we might live in him and he in us.

All: He opened his arms of love upon the cross and made for all the perfect sacrifice for sin.

Leader: On the night he was betrayed, at supper with his friends

he took bread, and gave you thanks; he broke it and gave it to them, saying:

Take, eat; this is my body which is given for

you; do this in remembrance of me.

All: Father, we do this in remembrance of him: his body is the bread of life.

Leader: At the end of supper, taking the cup of wine,

he gave you thanks, and said:

Drink this, all of you; this is my blood of the new covenant, which is shed for you for the

forgiveness of sins;

do this in remembrance of me.

All: Father, we do this in remembrance of him: his blood is shed for all.

Leader: As we proclaim his death and celebrate his

rising in glory, send your Holy Spirit that this bread and this wine may be to us the body and

blood of your dear Son.

All: As we eat and drink these holy gifts make us one in Christ, our risen Lord. Amen.

All are invited to come forward. Those who are baptised can extend their hands to receive the bread and wine. Those not yet baptised can cross their arms over their chest to receive a blessing.

Prayer after Communion:

Leader: Lord, we have broken your bread

and received your life.

By the power of your Spirit keep us always in your love

through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.
