Welcome:

*Presider:* Dear friends in Christ, during Lent we have been preparing for the celebration of our Lord's paschal mystery. On this day our Lord Jesus Christ entered the holy city of Jerusalem in triumph. The people welcomed Christ with palms and shouts of praise, but the path before him led to self-giving, suffering and death. Today we greet Christ as our King, although we know his crown is thorns and his throne a cross. We follow Christ this week from the glory of the palms to the glory of the resurrection by the dark road of suffering and death. United with Christ in his suffering on the cross, may we share his resurrection and new life.

*Presider:* Blessed is the one  
who comes in the name of the Lord!

*People:* **Hosanna in the highest!**

*A candle is lit.*

Prayer of Confession:

*During confession we all say sorry to God and ask for forgiveness for the wrong things (called sin) we've done and for the things we've thought in our minds that aren't pleasing to God. We all need God's forgiveness, so we ask for it. God has promised to always forgive us and never to remember our sin again.*

*Leader:* The sacrifice of God is a broken spirit;  
a broken and contrite heart God will not despise.  
Let us come to the Lord, who is full of  
compassion, and acknowledge our transgressions  
in penitence and faith.

*All:* **Wash away all my iniquity  
and cleanse me from my sin.  
Lord, have mercy.**

**Against you, you only have I sinned  
and done what is evil in your sight.  
Christ, have mercy.**

**Create in me a pure heart, O God,  
and renew a steadfast spirit within me.  
Lord, have mercy.**

Bible Reading:  
**Philippians 2:5-11**

You must have the same attitude that Christ Jesus had. Though he was God, he did not think of equality with God as something to cling to. Instead, he gave up his divine privileges; he took the humble position of a slave and was

born as a human being. When he appeared in human form, he humbled himself in obedience to God and died a criminal's death on a cross. Therefore, God elevated him to the place of highest honor and gave him the name above all other names, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue declare that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

*Reader:* The word of the Lord.

*People:* **Thanks be to God.**

Bible Reading:  
**Mark 11:1-11**

As Jesus and his disciples approached Jerusalem, they came to the towns of Bethphage and Bethany on the Mount of Olives. Jesus sent two of them on ahead. "Go into that village over there," he told them. "As soon as you enter it, you will see a young donkey tied there that no one has ever ridden. Untie it and bring it here. If anyone asks, 'What are you doing?' just say, 'The Lord needs it and will return it soon.'"

The two disciples left and found the colt standing in the street, tied outside the front door. As they were untying it, some bystanders demanded, "What are you doing, untying that colt?" They said what Jesus had told them to say, and they were permitted to take it. Then they brought the colt to Jesus and threw their garments over it, and he sat on it. Many in the crowd spread their garments on the road ahead of him, and others spread leafy branches they had cut in the fields. Jesus was in the center of the procession, and the people all around him were shouting, "Praise God! Blessings on the one who comes in the name of the Lord! Blessings on the coming Kingdom of our ancestor David! Praise God in highest heaven!" So Jesus came to Jerusalem

and went into the Temple. After looking around carefully at everything, he left because it was late in the afternoon. Then he returned to Bethany with the twelve disciples.

*Reader:* The Gospel of Christ.

*People:* **Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ.**
